RESPONSE QUESTIONS FOR STEVE HAAS VIDEO

In small groups...

Take some moments to reflect on the video and discuss the following questions. This time is meant to help you think through God's calling for you and our generation. Feel free to explore topics that come up, pursue tangents, and let the discussion take on a life of its own.

1. Considering the Reserve Police Battalion 101 and the Book of Acts, "ordinary men" may commit small acts that can lead to great evil or great good. What small acts of evil does our generation commit every day? What small "life-affirming acts" do we commit? What could we do better?
2. Steve said that a "generation of justice" would create a wave of life-affirming acts so that everyone could experience "life in all its fullness" (John 10:10). What does "life in all its fullness" look like? Is it different depending on your location?
3. What practical steps can we take to become so in tune with God's intention that anything out of alignment makes us uncomfortable?
4. Pray individually for wisdom and direction about how your group can help create a modern-day Book of Acts with your lives. As a group, discuss in what ways we can **show up**, **speak up** and **act up** on our campuses, churches and communities. Wrap up this time with prayer as a group.
